DISTRIBUTION LOGISTICS



80-90% of food distributed is **PERISHABLE**



40-50% of food distributed is **PRODUCE**

Needs to accommodate:

- → Variable donation sizes
- → 7 day a week donations
- → Short shelf life
- → Variable overall volume of food
- → Focus on zero waste



SOLUTION: FLEXIBLE DISTRIBUTION NETWORK

- → Subsidized housing
- → Housing authorities
- → Head start programs

- Food pantries & churches
- WIC offices
- → Job training centers
